

LaSal Mountains combo with Rafting the Colorado River /Cataract Canyon (5 days, 4 nights)

Thank you for choosing ADRIFT ADVENTURES! We are delighted to be able to share the La Sal Mountains and the Colorado River with you. We take great pride in our equipment as it's the finest in the business. Trail rides and boats are designed for passenger comfort and safety.

Our food is known for being among the best on the trail and river! Fresh salads, tasty halibut, healthy salmon, juicy steaks, barbecued chicken, stir fry, and much more will tantalize your taste buds throughout your stay. Our experienced and friendly guides are proud to be your hosts and they will help provide a vacation you'll talk about and remember for years to come.

There is a mandatory check-in after 3:00 PM the evening before your trip, to pick up your river bags and camera box. Our office is open until 7:00 PM each evening and is located at 378 North Main Street in Moab. Meeting time the morning of the trip is 9:00 AM.

DAY 1 AND 2: Meet ADRIFT ADVENTURES at the Moab office, 378 North Main at 9:00 AM. Leave your vehicle in our parking lot. There is a approximately 1 hour drive to base camp at the La Sal Mountains. You'll drive through the Canyonlands region. Don't be shocked if the area looks familiar. It has graced the screen of motion picture theaters across the land as a scenic back drop for numerous films. This two-day horseback trip in the La Sal Mountains outside of Moab will take you high into the mountains. The freshness of the air and the smells of pine will tantalize your senses. The peaceful feeling of just "getting away from it all" will leave you feeling content and inspired. After exploring the area for 2 days, you'll come back to the Adrift Office at 378 N Main and then disembark to your assigned hotel rooms. Dinner and breakfast on your own, then off for Cataract Canyon the next morning.

Our three-day motorized trip on the Colorado River averages out to a guide for every eight guests. This trip offers some of the wildest whitewater during the months of May/June and into July. From July through October, the river calms itself with lower waters; but by no means is placid! Please be aware that water levels fluctuate yearly and it is difficult to determine exact water flows during departure weeks. This trip is on a motorized J-Rig: This is one of the smallest motor vessels used on the river. This specially designed boat allows for safe, exciting rides at all water levels.

DAY 3: Meet Adrift Adventures at the Moab office, 378 N. Main at 7:30 a.m. Leave your vehicle in our parking lot and be transported to the river put-in via Adrift vehicles. Your first day will cover the flat waters of the Colorado River. There will be a few hikes to break up the day, ranging from five minutes to half an hour. You'll visit ancient Anasazi ruins, as well as pictographs over a thousand years in age. Camp is at river's shore. You're welcome to visit our library on the river or partake in horseshoes, volleyball or a little backgammon.

DAY 4: The rapids of Cataract Canyon! Big Drop, Mile Long and numerous others await your arrival. Your evening stories tell the tale of the day's events. Camp at river's shore.

DAY 5: You will motor off Lake Powell, with intermittent swim breaks and lunch. The trip will then end at Hite Marina in the early afternoon. Chartered transportation awaits your arrival and you'll be back in Moab approximately 3:00 to 4:00 p.m. Taking a van back takes approximately 3 hours and cost \$40.00 per person, flying approximately 1 hour and cost \$100.00 pp

Our crew offers a chance to explore the regions of Canyonlands and Cataract Canyon. Each trip is different, as we have people join us from around the country as well as abroad. You'll meet everlasting new friends and establish a relationship with the river's romance.
