



CATARACT CANYON EXPRESS TRIP

1 DAY CATARACT CANYON

This 120-mile expedition takes you through the notorious Cataract Canyon, which offers some of the wildest whitewater around. During the months of May and June we get our spring run-off, during this high water season is when the rapids are the most extreme. From July through October the water levels drop, but by no means does it make the river placid. Later summer offers pristine sandbars, warm water and plenty of sunshine. Rated as one of the best rafting trips in American this 1 day trip is spectacular for those who are looking for a quick dose of adventure. Rapid class varies depending *on* water **levels**; trips begin and end in Moab. Utah.

Depending on water levels you may be jet boated down to rafts which have left the day prior to. Trips depart from the Potash ramp on the Colorado River and conclude at Hite Marina on Lake Powell. All trips meet at our office, **378 North Main Street**. There is a **mandatory physical check-in** the day prior to your trips departure. **You should consider bringing** a hat or visor, camera and sunglasses. You have an optional **van ride (\$60 pp) or flight (\$130 pp)** back to **Moab**. Trip schedule is subject to change **based on** weather and water levels.
